Mass at 3:00pm, followed by the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Adoration, Procession in the Well Gardens, Prayers for the Sick and Benediction. This year's Adoration has a special meaning as our Holy Father asked that all bishops join with the Holy Father by celebrating in their own cathedrals an hour of Eucharistic Adoration, synchronised with the Vatican Basilica.
