The Gospel of today presents the story of a mother

whose only son, a young man, had died. And she was a widow. This means that she will no longer have any protection: neither husband nor son. Yet Jesus is there and restores life to the dead young man, the only son of his mother.

How many times most of us have wished that we had God's power and could restore a life to someone, for the sake of his or her family, for the sake of those grieving, for the sake of bringing joy once more to those who are in sorrow. Yet we find ourselves powerless, asking for God to please work a miracle. Both of the mothers in the Scripture today found themselves powerless.
