Faith is a complete trust in our

Lord Jesus and in His promises to us. The first reading today, from the Book of Wisdom, talks about the destruction of our enemies. Even our Jewish ancestors came to believe that our enemies are not those who threaten us, but the thoughts, words, actions and omissions that draw us into sin and away from the living God. The reality of these spiritual enemies is expressed by talking about physical enemies. Wisdom invites us to grow deep enough in the spiritual life to recognize that fighting anyone else other than ourselves is foolishness.

The Gospel today, from Saint Luke, invites us to gather treasures that last forever.

This continues the teaching from last Sun-

day. We must always be looking at the spiritual reality that surrounds us and envelops us so that we are aware that there is more to life than just what we see in the here and now.

It is so easy to forget that there is a world beyond this world. We forget that our struggle is not just to live in the here and now, but to live forever. Life eternal is our invitation.

The deeper we go into the life of faith, the more that is asked of us. Even when we fail and sin, God will continue to invite us and ask to be faithful once more and to abandon our sins.
