All Souls' Day

On November 2nd we commemorate all the faithful departed. We will have Mass in our church at 9:30am. There will be short prayer services at Holywell Cemetery (at 11:00am) and Greenfield Cemetery (at 12:30pm). The service at cemetery

includes: general prayers for the souls and blessing of graves/gravestones as requested. This will be a wonderful opportunity to show our respect and love for our beloved ones passed away.

A *Plenary Indulgence*, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (a) either visit a cemetery on any day between 1st and 8th of November or pray mentally for the dead; (b) or on All Souls' Day visit a church or chapel with devotion and there recite the *Our Father* and the *Creed*.

A *Partial Indulgence*, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any faithful who (a) visit devoutly a cemetery or who simply pray mentally for the dead; (b) recite devoutly Morning Prayer or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, or the invocation *Eternal Rest...*
