Minutes of the Parish Advisory Council (PAC)

PAC met on last Wednesday. The re-vamped social committee has met, and will now be known as the Friends of St. Winefride's Parish. We now have two pairs of men who count the collection alternatively. There is concern over the drop in the amount of money collected each week. The SVP thank everyone for their generosity in the recent second collection for them, around £100 was raised. We need new hymn books, and it was suggested that people may like to sponsor a hymn book, perhaps in memory of someone. The Vocationist Co-operators restart their meetings in October after the summer break, with a feeling of joy at the ordination to the priesthood of two of our students, especially as Luigi will be priest here. The UCM was thanked for providing the refreshments at the pilgrimage and also for the unseen work that they do all year round. The school has about 50/50 non-Catholics to Catholics, and it is sad to see so few children in Church; but we have a new deputy head and new teacher, both of whom are Catholics, so we hope to find ways to encourage children and parents to attend. It was felt that the pilgrimage went well, and that the marquis was a good idea, we hope to have it each year now. CAFOD fast day is 3rd October, our Harvest Festival will be on the 5th, with CAFOD collection. We hope to have a memorial for Sr Aidan. The unveiling of the statue in Tower gardens will be on 11th October, the Bishop will be there. We will be having a charity shop starting 17th November. We hope to have a parish Christmas Dinner, date etc. to be arranged. St. Winefride's Chapel needs tidying up, we may need to hire a skip.
