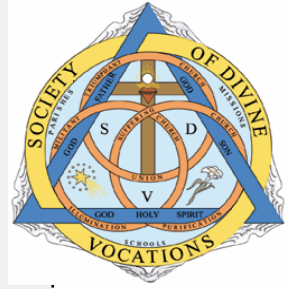

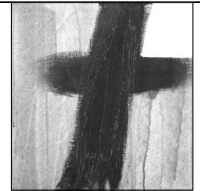

Mass with the Sick / Housebound:

Each Saturday in Lent, the priests will visit the sick and housebound of the parish and celebrate Mass with them. On Saturday 14th March there will be a Mass in Coed Duon Nursing Home at 10:15am.
